Criteria:

- Graduating high school senior or college freshman
- 17-20 years old (or military veteran of any age)
- U.S. citizen
- Must be from Monterey County
- Must be accepted to U.S. university or college

Requirements:

- fill out application (see application attached)
- write 2 x one page essays on each question (see questions attached)
- provide copy of college acceptance letter

Process:

- Provide MBRWF POC with book receipts and be refunded up to \$1,000 in Fall 2009.

Timeline:

Apr/May – advertise award (and other scholarships)

June 1 – deadline to receive applications

July 1 – committee reviews applications and chooses winners

Aug 1 – publicly announce winners

Essay Questions (pick two):

1. What are the obligations of citizenship?
2. Do you see your college education as a quest to prepare you for life or a quest to prepare you for a career?
3. What is the role of political parties in a free society?
4. How can your government better serve the needs of the people?
5. How do you think the role of government is defined per the U.S. Constitution?
